

# Carols of Christmas Gold Stardust Card

## Supplies:

**Stamps:** Carols of Christmas Bundle (146037); Star of Light (142110)

**Paper:** Gold Foil Paper (132622); Thick Very Vanilla (144237); Wild Wasabi (108641)

**Ink:** Versamark Ink (102283)

**Accents:** Gold Embossing Powder (109129);

**Tools:** Card Front Builder (part of the bundle 144674); Foam Adhesive Strips (141825); Gold Embossing Powder (109129); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Heat Tool (129053)

## Measurements:

Thick Very Vanilla: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", 5-1/4" x 4"

Gold Foil: 5-1/4" x 4", scraps for deer

Wild Wasabi: 3" x 4" scrap

## Instructions:

1. Use the Card Front Builder Thinlits to die-cut the frame on a 5-1/4" x 4" piece of Very Vanilla Thick card stock. Line the die up to the top as close as you can get to the edge. Run through the Big Shot, then repeat on the opposite end.
2. Stamp a few stars from the Carols of Christmas Set in VersaMark Ink along the top of the Very Vanilla die-cut layer, sprinkle with Gold Embossing Powder, then heat-set with the Heat Tool until glossy & smooth.
3. Die-cut the Wild Wasabi trees with the Card Front Builder dies. You'll need two of the double tree and one of the single tree.
4. Stamp the stardust swirl image from Star of Light set in Versamark ink across the trees. Sprinkle Gold Embossing Powder and heat set with a Heat Tool until glossy & smooth.
5. Die-cut two Gold Foil deer using the Card Front Builder dies.
6. Adhere trees and deer to the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
7. Stamp the sentiment from Star of Light in Versamark after adhering the trees for better positioning. Heat emboss with Gold Embossing Powder.
8. Adhere the die-cut & stamped layer to a 5-1/4" x 4" Gold Foil mat, then pop up onto a Very Vanilla Thick card stock card base with Foam Strips.
