

Succulent Diagonal Gate Fold Card

Supplies:

Stamps – Oh So Succulent (142992)

Paper – Succulent Garden DSP (142778), Tip Top Taupe (138336), Mint Macaron (138337)

Ink – Rich Razzleberry (115316), White Craft (101731)

Tools - Succulent Framelits (142757), Layering Circles Framelits (141705), Big Shot (143263), Stampin' Trimmer (126889), Sponge (141337), Bone Folder (102300), Dimensionals (104430), Glue Dots (103683), SNAIL (104332)

Measurements:

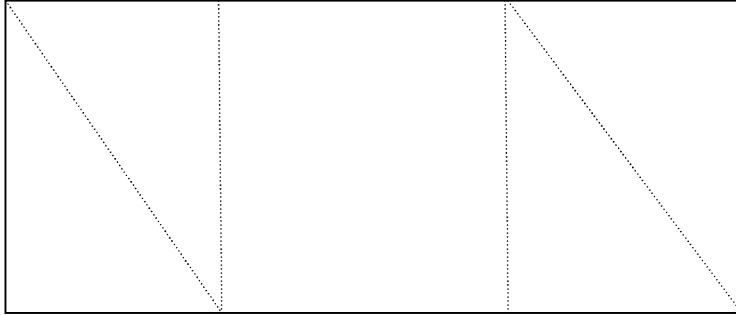
Tip Top Taupe: 5-1/2" X 8-1/4" and 3" x 3" scrap for scalloped circle

Succulent DSP: 2 pieces measuring 2-1/4" X 4-7/8"

Mint Macaron: 5-1/2" X 8-1/2"

Instructions:

1. Die cut the 5 different sizes of the Succulent Framelits flower layers out of the Mint Macaron card stock.
2. Sponge flowers in Rich Razzleberry and then sponge over in white.
3. Curl the petals with your fingers or a Bone Folder.
4. Adhere the flower together with Glue Dots or Dimensionals.
5. Score a 5-1/2" x 8-1/4" piece of Tip Top Taupe on the long side at the 2-3/4" and 5-1/2" marks.
6. Score diagonally on the first and third panels as shown below:



- 7.** Cut two 2-1/4" x 4-7/8" pieces of Succulent Garden DSP. Cut them both diagonally, taking care to cut them so you have the DSP positioned in the direction that you want.
- 8.** Adhere DSP to the triangles on the card base.
- 9.** Die-cut a Tip Top Taupe scalloped circle with 2nd largest Layering Circles die.
- 10.** Adhere the succulent to the scalloped circle with Glue Dots or Dimensionals.
- 11.** Adhere the circle to the front of the card with Glue Dots or Dimensionals, making sure to only apply adhesive to 1/2 of the back.
