Supplies:

Stamps: Builder Birdcage (142891)

Ink: Archival Black (140931); Basic Gray Archival (140932)

Paper: Succulent Garden Designer Series Paper (142778); Very Vanilla (101650); Sweet Sugarplum (141418); Basic Gray (121044)

Accents: Rhinestone Basic Jewels (119246)

Tools: Layering Ovals Framelits (141706); Falling Petals Textured Embossing Folder (142761); Big Shot (143263); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); SNAIL (104332)

Measurements:

Sweet Sugarplum Card Stock: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" (score at 4-1/4")

Very Vanilla Card Stock: 5-1/4" x 4"; scrap for sentiment

Basic Gray Card Stock: 5-1/4" x 2-1/2"; scrap for scallop oval behind sentiment

Sweet Sugarplum Gingham DSP: 5-1/4" x 2-1/4"

Instructions:

1. Emboss the 5-1/4" x 4" piece of Very Vanilla card stock using the Falling Petals Textured Embossing Folder and adhere to the front of the Sweet Sugarplum card base.
2. Stamp the Builder Birdcage images onto the 2-1/4" x 5-1/4" Succulent Garden DSP in Archival Black Ink. **TIP:** Start at the bottom and work your way up.
3. Adhere the stamped layer to a 2-1/2" x 5-1/4" mat of Basic Gray and adhere it to the Vanilla layer with SNAIL.
4. Stamp the greeting in Archival Gray Ink onto Very Vanilla card stock and cut out with the Layering Ovals Framelit that measures 2-1/4" across.
5. Cut one scalloped ovals from Basic Grey using the Layering Ovals Framelits that measures 2-3/8" across.
6. Pop up the Vanilla greeting over the Basic Gray oval with Dimensionals.
7. Adhere the ovals layers to the card as shown above using SNAIL.
8. Embellish the bottom of the birdcage with the Basic Rhinestone Jewels as shown.
