

Alpine Snowfall Season's Greetings

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Supplies:

Stamp Sets – Feathers & Frost (147771)

Paper – Crumb Cake (120953); Real Red (102482); Bermuda Bay (131197); Joyous Noel Glimmer Paper (147817); Vellum Cardstock (101856)

Stamp Pads – Bermuda Bay (147096)

Accents – Basic Adhesive Backed Sequins (146933); Very Vanilla Baker's Twine (144224)

Tools – Alpine Sports Thinlits Dies (147916); Snowfall Thinlits Dies (149692); Softly Falling Embossing Folder (139672); Liquid Glue (110755); Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Measurements:

Crumb Cake Cardstock- 5 ½" x 8 ½" score @ 4 ¼"; and 4" x 5 ¼" layer

Real Red Cardstock- 3 ½" x 2"

Joyous Noel Glimmer Paper- 4" x ¼"

Bermuda Bay Cardstock- 4" x ¾"

Vellum cardstock- 4" x 4"

Instructions:

1. Emboss the 4" x 5 ¼" Crumb Cake layer with the Softly Falling Embossing Folder.
2. Die-cut the large snowflake from the Snowfall Thinlits Dies with using Vellum Cardstock. Then attach it to the embossed layer with a couple of Glue Dots in the center.
3. Die-cut the sled from the Alpine Sports Thinlits Dies using Real Red Cardstock. Attach over the top of the snowflake using a couple of Glue Dots.
4. Stamp your sentiment in Bermuda Bay ink on a 4" x ¾" piece of Bermuda Bay cardstock. Attach to the front of the sled using Glue Dots. SNAIL adhesive does not stay down but Glue Dots did the trick!
5. Attach the 4" x ¼" Joyous Noel Glimmer Paper strip to the top edge of the Bermuda Bay cardstock with Multipurpose Liquid Glue. You must hold it for a few seconds, but it will stay!
6. Tie a 15" piece of Very Vanilla Baker's Twine around the Crumb Cake layer and tie a bow. Then, attach the whole layer to your Crumb Cake card front with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
7. Lastly, add a few white Adhesive Backed Sequins to your card front.
