

Beautiful Autumn Beautiful Day Card

Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – *Beautiful Autumn* (153450); Bundle with Autumn Punch Pack (155189)
- **Card Stock** – Thick Whisper White (140272); Whisper White (100730); Brushed Metallic Cardstock (153524)
- **Stamp Pads** – Early Espresso (126974); So Saffron (126957)
- **Misc.** – Plaid Tidings Designer Series Paper (DSP) (153527); Rectangular Postage Stamp Punch (152709); Autumn Punch Pack (153609); Paper Snips (103579); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin' SEAL (152813)

Measurements:

- Card Stock 1: Thick Whisper White card base 8 ½" x 5 ½"
- Card Stock 2: Whisper White approx. 4 ½" x 2 ½"
- Card Stock 3: Brushed Metallic (2 finishes) Lighter one 5 ¼" x 2" & darker one approx. 2 ½" x 1"
- Card Stock 4: So Saffron strip 3" x 5/8"
- DSP: Plaid Tidings DSP 5 ¼" x 4"

Instructions:

1. Fold thick Whisper White card base in half at 4 ¼" and adhere the Plaid Tidings DSP to the card front with Stampin' SEAL.
2. Add the lighter Brushed Metallic cardstock to the right side of the card front also with Stampin' SEAL.
3. Punch 3 postage stamp shapes using Whisper White cardstock.
4. Stamp the branch on the postage stamp shapes in So Saffron ink. Alternate the sides that you stamp the branch on each punched shape.

5. You can now attach the postage stamps to the card front like in the picture using Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Using the Autumn Punch Pack punch out one of each leaf and one acorn using the darker Brushed Metallic cardstock piece. Attach each one to a different postage stamp using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
7. Stamp your sentiment using Early Espresso Ink on the So Saffron cardstock strip.
8. Use your paper snips to cut the words apart in the sentiment. Add each word to your card front like the sample using liquid glue.
