

# Bloom Where You're Planted Shelf Card

## Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Plentiful Plants Bundle (155688)
- **Card Stock:** Evening Evergreen (155574); Garden Green (102584); Basic White (159276); Cinnamon Cider (153078)
- **Stamp Pads:** Old Olive (147090); Garden Green (147089); Pale Papaya (155670)
- **Misc. :** Bloom Where You're Planted Designer Series Paper (155696); Paper Lattice (155697); Tasteful Textile 3D Embossing folder (152718); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Fine Tip Glue Pen (138309); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Stampin' Seal (152813)

## Measurements:

- Cinnamon Cider: 5½" x 8½" scored at 4¼", strip ½" x 3¾"
- Basic White: 4" x 5¼", scraps for plants and pot
- Evening Evergreen: 3 small scraps
- Garden Green: small scrap
- Paper Lattice: 3¼" x 2¼"
- DSP: 3¾" x 5"

## Instructions:

1. Stamp your choice of leaves in both Garden Green and Old Olive onto the basic white cardstock. Cut out with the coordinating dies and your Stampin' Up Cut and Emboss machine
2. Stamp the plant pot on Basic White with Pale Papaya ink. Cut out with the coordinating Perfect Plant dies.
3. Cut out 3 different plant pots using the Perfect Plant Dies and Evening Evergreen cardstock
4. Cut out a plant from Garden Green cardstock.
5. Cut the paper lattice accent after the 4th set of diamonds by snipping the connections carefully.
6. Adhere the Basic White layer to the card front using Stampin' Seal.
7. Adhere the Bloom Where you are Planted Patterned paper layer to the Basic White layer using Stampin' Seal.
8. Using the fine tip glue pen, add small drops of glue to some of the diamonds and edges of the paper lattice accent. Place on the patterned paper layer with the cut edge at the bottom as shown. I recommend placing a stamping block on top for a minute or so to allow the glue to set.
9. Emboss the Cinnamon Cider strip with the Tasteful Textile embossing folder to give the appearance of wood. Adhere to the bottom of the paper lattice accent.
10. Arrange the plants as shown. Adhere with a mix of adhesive and Stampin' Dimensionals to give a variety of heights and depth to the card.
