

Blooms & Bliss Gold Foil Flower Cards

Stamps: Labeler Alphabet (141936 polymer)

Inks: Archival Black Ink (140931)

Paper: Blooms & Bliss DSP (141654); Gold Foil (132622); Island Indigo (122923) card #1, Mint Macaron (138337) card #2, Basic Black (121045) & Whisper White (100730)

Accents: Pop of Pink Washi Tape (141649), Mint Macaron 3/8" Sheer Linen Ribbon (141656)

Tools: Sunshine Wishes Thinlits (141489) card #1, May Flowers Thinlits (140276) card #2, Big Shot (113439), Seaside Texture Impressions Folder (141481) card #1, Petal Burst Texture Impressions Folder (141493) card #2, Fine-Tip Glue Pen (138309), Dimensionals (104430), SNAIL (104332)

Paper Measurements:

Card base: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" scored and folded at 4-1/4"

Textured background layer: 4" x 2-1/2"

Blooms & Bliss DSP: 2-3/4" x 3-3/4"

Basic Black mat layer: 3" x 4"

Instructions:

1. Texture emboss Island Indigo or Mint Macaron background layer, then adhere to the bottom of the matching card front.
2. Adhere the Blooms & Bliss DSP to the Basic Black mat.
3. Wrap gold foil Pop of Pink Washi tape around bottom of the DSP layer.
4. Wrap Mint Macaron ribbon around the DSP layer and tie into a double-knot & trim ends.
5. Attach the DSP layer to the card front with Dimensionals.
6. Die-cut the Sunshine Wishes or May Flowers flower from Gold Foil & adhere to the focal layer with the Fine-Tip Glue Pen.
7. Stamp a custom word with the Labeler Alphabet letters in Black ink onto Whisper White, then hand-trim & pop up with Dimensionals onto card front.
