

Botanical Prints Decorative Squares Card

Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Botanical Prints Product Medley (151301)
- **Inks:** Crushed Curry (131173); Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)
- **Paper:** Whisper White (100730); Crushed Curry (131199); Copper Foil Sheets (142020)
- **Other:** Mini Glue Dots (103683); So Saffron Blends Combo (149557); Granny Apple Green Blends Combo (147274); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); SNAIL Adhesive (104332)

Measurements:

- Crushed Curry: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" ~ scored at 4 1/4"
- Whisper White: 4" x 5 1/4" (inside) plus scraps to stamp on
- Copper Foil: 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" plus scraps for square die-cuts
- Designer Series Paper: 2" x 5 1/2"

Instructions:

1. Fold Crushed Curry cardstock in half and adhere the Copper strip & DSP to the front.
2. Stamp the fruit stamp on Whisper White cardstock and color with the Blends - use the light blend first, shade with the dark blend and return with the light blend over the shading.
3. Die-cut the fruit stamped image. Die cut four triangles from the Copper Foil.
4. Adhere the triangles to the card front creating two square designs Use Mini Glue Dots on the back of the triangle corners ~ they do not show on the finished card.
5. Adhere the die cut-fruit over the bottom square made from the rectangles ~ using SNAIL.
6. Inside the card: Stamp saying on the Whisper White using Crushed Curry ink. Adhere die-cut accent at the bottom of the cardstock.
7. To line the envelope ~ Cut matching 6" x 6" designer series paper in half. Trace the top flap of the envelope on to the designer series paper and cut on the line. Place this piece inside the envelope and fold on the envelope flap line ~ use your bone folder to get a good crease. Open the flap and add 2" of SNAIL under the glue line on the envelope, close the flap to attach the lining.
