

Geared Up Garage Checkerboard Card

Supplies:

Stamp Sets – Geared Up Garage (148590 cling)

Paper – Basic Gray (121044); Whisper White (100730); Basic Black (121045); Real Red (102482); Silver Foil Sheets (132178)

Ink – Memento Tuxedo Black (132708); Basic Gray (149165); Real Red Stampin' Blends Marker Combo (147935), Smoky Slate Stampin' Blends Marker Combo (145058), Dark Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blends Marker (144585)

Tools – Garage Gears Framelits (148521); Pattern Party Decorative Masks (144103); Stamping Sponges (141337); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)

Measurements:

Basic Gray: 8 1/2" x 5 1/2" scored at 4 1/4"

Whisper White: 2" x 6" and a scrap piece to cut out car

Basic Black: 1/2" x 2 1/2" –6 strips

Real Red: 2 1/4" x 5 1/2"

Silver Foil: 4 1/4" x 5 1/2"

Instructions:

1. Fold 8-1/2" x 5-1/2" Basic Gray cardstock in half for the card base.
2. Lay the Pattern Party Decorative Masks brick pattern over the 5-1/2" x 2-1/4" Real Red cardstock and sponge with Basic Gray ink only around the edges of the cardstock. Leave the center of the piece very lightly sponged, because the sentiment will go here.
3. Stamp the Geared Up Garage sentiment in Memento Tuxedo Black ink.
4. Die-cut all the gears from the Garage Gears Framelits out of Silver Foil.
5. Stamp the Geared Up Garage car on scrap Whisper White cardstock with Memento Tuxedo Black ink. Die-cut the image with Garage Gears dies.
6. Color the card with Stampin' Blends Markers in Real Red, Smoky Slate and Daffodil Delight colors.

7. Create a Basic Black and Whisper White checkerboard background on the bottom of the card.

8. Adhere gears to front of card with Multipurpose Glue, then mount the card over the top with Dimensionals.
9. Glue any leftover gears to inside of card for a coordinating decoration.



How To Make Black and White Checkerboard: Mark 6" x 2" Whisper White piece every 1/2" with a pencil along 6" side (once on top and once on bottom). Using Multipurpose Glue, adhere six 1/2" x 2-1/2" Basic Black strips onto the white piece in-between pencil marks to create white and black stripes.



Trim down the striped sheet into four 1/2" x 6" pieces.



Glue these strips onto bottom of Basic Gray card base alternating black and white sections. Trim off any parts that are hanging over the edge.
