Stampin' Up! Supplies:

- STAMPS – Good Morning Magnolia (149298 cling), Good Morning Magnolia Bundle (151087 cling)
- PAPER – Petal Pink Cardstock (146985), Whisper White Cardstock (100730), Magnolia Lane Designer Series Paper (149484)
- INK – Mossy Meadow (147111), Early Espresso (147114), Stampin' Blends: Petal Pink Combo (147272), Mossy Meadow Light (148545), Bronze (144607), Color Lifter (144608)
- OTHER – Magnolia Memory dies (149578), Subtle 3D Embossing Folder (151775), Stitched Rectangle dies (148551), Stitched Nested Label dies (149638), Petal Pink 5/8" Organdy Striped Ribbon (149441), Basic Pearl Jewels (144219), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), SNAIL Adhesive (104332)

Cutting & Scoring:

- Petal Pink Cardstock – 5 1/2" x 8 1/2", score and fold at 4 1/4"
- Magnolia Lane DSP – 4" x 5 1/4"
- Whisper White Cardstock – 3 3/4" x 5"; 2" x 4" and 2" x 2" scraps for die-cuts
- Ribbon – 5 1/2"

Instructions:

- Die-cut a 4" long Rectangle Stitched die-cut from the center of the 4" x 5 1/4" Magnolia Lane DSP.
- Adhere the outer part of the DSP onto a Petal Pink card base.
- Emboss 3 3/4" x 5" piece of Whisper White cardstock with Subtle folder and adhere rectangle DSP on it.
- Wrap Organdy Striped ribbon around the layers, securing the ends on the back. Mount onto card front.
- Die-cut a Whisper White 1 3/4" x 3 1/4" Stitched Nested Label and stamp Good Morning Magnolia sentiment on the bottom of it with Mossy Meadow ink. Pop up onto the card front with Dimensionals.
- Stamp the Good Morning Magnolia flower in Early Espresso ink onto Whisper White. Color with Stampin' Blends Markers: Petal Pink and Color Lifter for the petals, Mossy Meadow for leaves, Bronze for stem.
- Die cut the flower with the Magnolia Memories dies and pop up with Dimensionals.
- Add a few Basic Pearl Jewels around the flower.
