

Quite Curvy Happiest of Birthdays Card



Supplies:

Stamps – Quite Curvy Bundle (156228)

Paper – Coastal Cabana (131297); Whisper White (100730); Night of Navy (100867); Misty Moonlight (153081); Purple Posy (150881); Playing with Patterns 6"x6" Designer Series Paper (152490);

Ink – Memento Tuxedo Black (132708); Stampin' Blends Marker: Pool Party (154894); Crumb Cake (154882)

Misc. – Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Wreath Builder Dies (152722); Mini Glue Dots (103683); Wrapped in Texture Embossing Folder (153574), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Bone Folder (102300); Paper Snips (103579); Mini Stampin' Dimensionals (144108);

Measurements:

- Coastal Cabana: 5 1/2" x 8" scored at 4", scraps
- Playing With Patterns DSP: 1 3/4" x 4 7/8"
- Night of Navy: 3 3/4" x 5", scraps
- Misty Moonlight: scraps
- Whisper White: 3" x 4 7/8", scraps;
- Purple Posy: scraps

Instructions:

1. Die-cut 3" x 4 7/8" piece of Whisper White with the wavy dotted die from the Curvy dies.
2. Place the Quite Curvy sentiment on the clear block. Adjust the curve of the text to follow the curve of the holes on the die cut. Stamp text in black ink.
3. Adhere DSP to the bottom edge of Night of Navy card stock. Adhere the Whisper White die cut to the top edge of the Night of Navy card stock. Mount layers onto a Coastal Cabana card base.
4. Stamp two birds on scraps of Whisper White card stock & color with Pool Party and Crumb Cake Stampin' Blends. Die-cut the birds with coordinating dies from the Curvy dies.
5. Die-cut 2 each of Coastal Cabana and 2 each Misty Moonlight leaf branches with the die from Curvy dies. Die-cut flower with Purple Posy scrap with flower die from the Wreath Builder dies. Die-cut Night of Navy flower center with die from the Wreath Builder dies. Emboss the flower center with the Wrapped In Texture Embossing Folder.
6. Adhere the leaves to the upper right side of card front – see picture for placement. Adhere flower center to flower with Multipurpose Glue. Adhere flower to card front with Mini Dimensionals. Adhere birds to card front with Multipurpose Glue.
