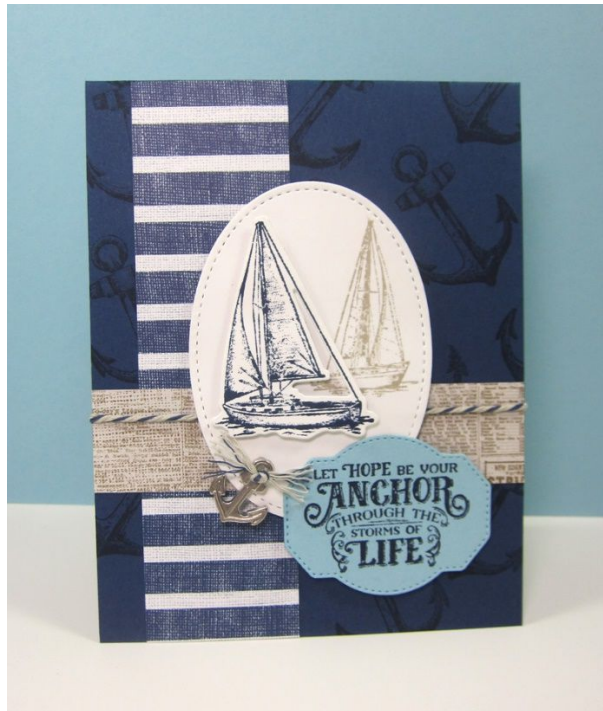


Sailing Away Anchor Through Storms Card

Stampin' Up! Supplies:

- STAMPS – Sailing Home Bundle (151066 Cling)
- PAPER – Night of Navy (100867), Balmy Blue (146982), Whisper White (100730), Come Sail Away Designer Series Paper (149481)
- INK – Night of Navy (147110), Sahara Sand (147117)
- OTHER – Night of Navy/Sahara Sand Baker's Twine (149483), Sail Away Trinkets (149482), Stitched Shapes dies (145372), SNAIL Adhesive (104332), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Glue Dots (103683)

Cutting & Scoring:

- Night of Navy - 4 ¼" x 11" (score and fold at 5 ½")
- Balmy Blue – 2 ½" x 2" scrap for die-cut
- Whisper White – 5" x 4 ¼" scrap for oval and sailboat die-cuts
- DSP – 1 ½" x 5 ½" stripes; 4 ¼" x 1" newsprint
- Baker's Twine – 14"

Instructions:

- Stamp the anchor image in Night of Navy ink randomly all over the Night of Navy card front.
- Adhere the striped DSP down the left side of the card front with SNAIL.
- Adhere the newsprint DSP on the lower half of the card front with SNAIL.
- Wrap Baker's Twine around card front, tie into a knot which will hide under the focal point.
- Die-cut a Whisper White oval with the Stitched Shapes dies.
- Stamp the small sailboat in Sahara Sand onto the Whisper White oval die-cut.
- Stamp the large sailboat in Night of Navy ink onto the Whisper White oval die-cut, overlapping with the other sailboat.
- Stamp the large sailboat in Night of Navy ink onto scrap, then die-cut it and pop up with Dimensionals.
- Mount the oval onto the card front with Dimensionals.
- Die-cut the Smooth Sailing label in Balmy Blue cardstock, then stamp the sentiment in Night of Navy onto it and pop up with Dimensionals under the oval.
- Adhere a Sailing Away Trinket with a Mini Glue Dot onto the oval.
- Tie a knot in the Baker's Twine, unravel the twine to fray it, then attach with Mini Glue Dot to trinket.
