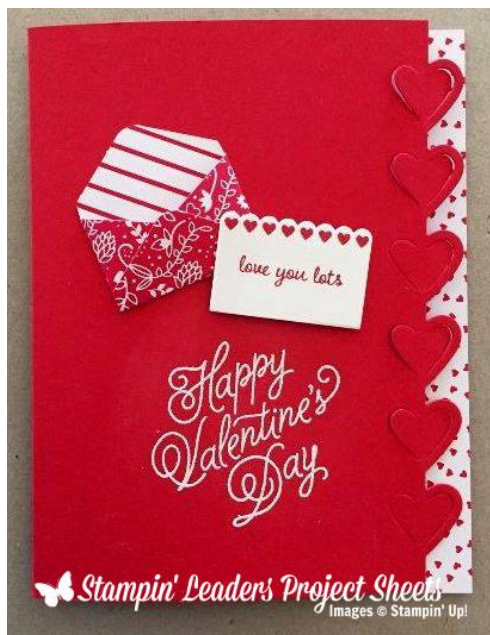


Sealed With Love Red Love Note

Supplies:

Stamps: Sealed with Love (142815) OR Sealed With Love (144705)

Paper: Sending Love Designer Series Paper Stack (142733); Real Red (102482), Whisper White (100730)

Ink: VersaMark (102283), Real Red (126949)

Accents: White Embossing Powder (109132)

Tools: Love Notes Framelits Dies (142752) or Bundle (144705), Big Shot (143263), Heat Gun (129053), Mini Glue Dots (103683), Dimensionals (104430), Embossing Buddy (103083)

Measurements:

Real Red: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"

DSP: 2" x 5-1/2" plus scrap for envelope

Whisper White: Scrap for love note

Instructions:

1. Create Real Red base card. Lay 'line of hearts' die on the edge of the right side of the card with the hearts just touching the edge, run through the Big Shot. (Adding wax paper between the die and the card stock will allow the heart design to pop out easily.)
2. Stamp 'Happy Valentine's Day' in VersaMark in the center front of the card near the base. Emboss with White embossing powder.
3. Adhere the 2" x 5-1/2" strip of DSP to the inside of the card, under the heart design.
4. Make small envelope using the die, fold in to envelope shape and adhere with a glue dot. Add to the base card with glue dots or SNAIL adhesive.
5. Stamp the tiny row of hearts and the saying on the Whisper White scrap, cut out the love note with the scalloped die. Attach to the card with a Dimensional.
